## A BHL

For the construction, improvement, extension, and repair of the buildings, roads, and grounds at Fort Walla Walla, in Washington Territory.
1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3 That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, out of any money 4 in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of forty5 two thousand dollars for the construction, improvement, ex6 tension, and repair of the buildings, roads, and grounds at 7 and in the vicinity of Fort Walla Walla, in Washington 8 Territory, including the construction and repair of the roads 9 between said fort and the railroad depot and other points in 10 the city of Walla Walla; and that the same be expended 11. under the direction of the Secretary of War.
