
#### DECLARATION.

WE, participants in the civil war of 1861 to 1865, believe that the end of that war ended all causes and conditions which created it, and established the unity and integrity of the Government for all time. We believe that twenty-five years of peace ought to have obliterated all animosities and prejudice engendered by the war.

We believe that our children, who were innocent of the cause, as they were ignorant of the curses and devastations of that war, should be protected from the moral, social and political evils arising therefrom.

We believe that men who gave patriotic service in response to duty (as they saw their duty) deserve honorable consideration of their countrymen. We believe that brave soldiers, though enemies in war, are and ought to be friends in peace, they and their descendants forever.

In order to perpetuate these principles we invoke the blessing of Divine Providence, pledge fealty to ourselves, our families, and our common country, and band ourselves together for mutual benefit and fraternal good will, under the name and title of the Order of United American Veterans, with the motto, "Charity and Unity: the Blue and the Gray" and for the purpose of union of all veterans who did honorable service in the armies of the United States or of the Confederates States during the civil war, and agree to be governed by the articles of incorporation.
