## MRETING INANGE COMAITTEE

OF STATE COMMTXTES:

For the information of Men:bers of the State committee the following memoranda is herewith subritted on the action taken at a Special Meeting of the Finance committee, held March 6th, 1891, at \#191 Broadway, upon matters "eferred to them:

PRESENT: Dr. Warner, Chairman, and Messr's. McConaughy, Law and Schenck.

VOTFD that office Socretary be anthorized to engage a stenographer for a period of throo months from March lst at not exceeding ten dollars per week. (§10)

VOTED that Chairman Warner be requested to confer with Mr. Griffith, and if practicablo to effect an agreonent with him for his continuance as Secretary for another year, giving his whole time to the work, at the sarce salary as last year, $\$ 2000$.

A letter was read from M. S. P. Platt conveying the withdrawal of the resignation of 'r. J. G. Wilkinson as a member of the State Comrittee,

IT was also reportod that M. S. T. Adans of Buffalo still desires that his resignation as a morber of the State Comrittee be accepted.

VOTED that, with the joint approval of the Advisory Committee, and by authority of the Resolution of the State comrittee adopted at Lockport, Pebruary 2lst, 1.891, the rasignation of Mr. S. E.Adar.s as a nember of the State comritteo be accepted, and that lir. J. S. Helmer of Jockport be choson a nombor of the Stato comrittee to fill the vacancy.

THE Secretary of the Finance Comrittee was directed to so advise Mr. George C. Sawyer, Chairman of the Advisory Committee.

Dr. Warner reported a conversation with Mr. Sumner F. Dudey concerning the "Eoys Work" throlughout the State, and recommended that Mr. Dudley be engaged as an Assistant Secretary.

UPON MOTION it was voted that the Chairman be erpowered to engage the sorvices of Mr. Dudley as an Assistant Secretary at $\$ 500$ per annum, Mr. Dudley to give ono third of his time to the work, and his services to be with specia? but not exclusive refer-- ence to Boys Departments throughout the State.
