
My dear General; -

Your favor of May 18th received. So far I have been unable to induce the Pacific Mail people to take any interest in this venture. I have spent considerable time in personal interviews and solicitation, but without fruit. I was anxious to be of service to you in the matter, and am impressed by the new suggestion that this might be a valuable coaling station for the United States government. The price of coal delivered at Aspinwall has been reduced to about \$3. Alabama coal delivered at Mobile at \$2. finds transportation to the Isthmus at \$1. which proves so attractive to the vessel owners that it has been impossible to induce them to spend any money to develop mines on the coast. If I can be of service to you in developing the new idea I shall deem it a privilege and pleasure.


