



Scale 80 poles per Inch



At the request of Mr. Isaac Haynes, I surveyed his land in Fairfax lying North of the Little River Turnpike. Beginning at a *A*, a drain making into Accotink Run comes to Mr. Gooding Sr. and running with him  $S 54^{\circ} N 26$  poles to centre of M. & D. R. continued to  $36$  poles to *B*, a marked Red Oak,  $N 87^{\circ} W 152$  poles to *C*, a stake on the edge of Paynes Old Mill road,  $S 13^{\circ} E 8 \frac{1}{2}$  poles to a Gum at the fence corner, at *D*,  $S 77^{\circ} E 99$  poles to *E* a lane,  $S 10^{\circ} E 60$  poles to *F* the Little River Turnpike Road, down the road  $S 79^{\circ} E 99$  poles  $N 82^{\circ} E 25$  poles to *G*, opposite the House,  $S 77^{\circ} E 130$  poles to *H*, the Mill Lot with said lot  $N 18^{\circ} W 142 \frac{1}{2}$  poles to centre of M. & D. R.  $202 \frac{1}{2}$  poles to *I* a large marked White Oak on the West abutment of Paynes Mill dam thence up Accotink  $N 39^{\circ} W 10 \frac{1}{2}$  poles  $S 41^{\circ} W 17$  poles  $S 35^{\circ} W 18$  poles  $S 55^{\circ} W 17 \frac{1}{2}$  poles  $S 37^{\circ} W 17$  poles  $S 71^{\circ} W 26$  poles  $N 55^{\circ} W 17$  poles to the Beginning containing 200 Acres more or less


