ing with such success as to honor his native State.

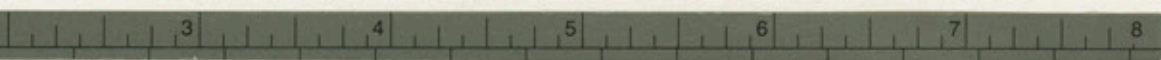
Resolved, That the Legislature of Maine would take
