EDWIN JOHN BEINECKE, of New York City, influential business executive and bank and corporation director; a man of affairs who in the Second World War rendered outstanding service to the American Red Cross, and was honored as the first recipient of the Medal for Freedom granted by the Army to civilians; greatly and helpfully interested in the library of Yale University; known to bibliophiles for his memorable collection of the works of Robert Louis Stevenson; for other human interests and for his friendliness to liberal education.
