CHARLES THORNTON LIBBY, of Yarmouth; of good Brunswick stock though somehow deflected to Harvard for his formal education; pioneer author in varied fields of economics and government; historian of colonial days whose recent contributions in editing for the Maine Historical Society the Province and Court Records of Maine have been placed by eminent authority among the most important volumes ever issued for the early social and economic history of the Colonies; whose work is a standing commentary to the truth that real scholarship depends more upon the spirit within than upon technical training and advanced university degrees; now gladly made a member of this society of scholars.
