

HARRY OAKES, of the Class of 1896, of Nassau; Overseer of the College; native of Maine, now a British subject, whose adventure in mining and prospecting took him to Alaska, the Philippines, Mexico, and South Africa and also to Australia where he found his chiefest treasure in Lady Oakes; President and Managing Director of Lake Shore Mines, Kirkland Lake, Ontario; created a Baronet by King George in 1939 for public and philanthropic services to Great Britain and Canada, hence Sir Harry Oakes, but known at Bowdoin as Harry Oakes, generous benefactor to our art collections.
