

ROBERT PORTER PATTERSON, of Washington, Under Secretary of War; Bachelor of Arts of Union College, Bachelor of Laws of Harvard University where like Senator Brewster he was editor of the *Harvard Law Review*; Major in the first World War with Distinguished Service Cross for extraordinary heroism in action; eminent in the law and on the bench; serving, while still a young man, as Federal District Judge, then Circuit Judge of Appeals in New York City; since July, 1940, in the War Department, first as Assistant and later as Under Secretary of War, in which office he frequently takes the place of his chief, Secretary Stimson, whose hard work, keen ability and high patriotism have won the praise of political opponents and the confidence of the American people, as a graduate of a highly esteemed sister college of liberal arts, doubly welcome here.
