

MAXWELL DAVENPORT TAYLOR, Major General, United States Army, Superintendent of the United States Military Academy, West Point; graduate of that Academy in 1922, honorary Doctor of Engineering from New York University; distinguished soldier with service in many quarters of the globe, and with a war record noteworthy for leadership and extraordinary personal heroism; decorated not only many times by his own country but also by Great Britain, France, Belgium, and the Netherlands; well known to Maine people for his adventurous trip accompanied by Colonel Tudor Gardiner through the German lines before the Armistice to negotiate with Badoglio in Rome, “with complete disregard of the imminent danger involved and without thought of personal safety”; able, enlightened and human Superintendent of West Point with which for many years this college has had the most friendly relations; for his service to education and to his country and for high personal character.
