Dear Sarah.

We are back again after just one week of very hard campaigning we have made the greatest raid of the war (our Corps) we have torn up the Weldon R.R. more than half way to Weldon and destroyed much property &c &c. we returned to our old ground last night and are now ordered to be ready for another move, but it is said that if we move again it will be only a very short move.

Lawrence stood the march well and is very well now.

I am Provost Marshal of the 1<sup>st</sup> Division 5<sup>th</sup> Army Corps. was appointed on the 5<sup>th</sup> inst. I like very well indeed, although it is a responsible position, but

there is no fighting to do. I can do the  
business just like a book and after  
we get settled down into winter time  
it will be a very easy place.

I shall take another place if I do not  
like this place, but I have no doubt  
I shall like this position very well.

The next time you write, you  
may direct to Capt V. D. C. Pro. Mar-  
1<sup>st</sup> Div - 5<sup>th</sup> Corps. or Capt V. D. C.

Head Quarters 1<sup>st</sup> Division 5<sup>th</sup> Corps.  
either will do. Do not send any  
more to the Regt as I shall not
