My Dear Sir,

When in Washington  
recently I got the Treasury  
dept. to pass upon our War claim  
accounts this being, and on  
its being allowed I promised  
to the Treasurer of Maine the U.S.  
Treasurer's draft for the amt. viz:  
\$10,682.23 which should properly  
appear in your accounts.

In response to my inquiries  
as to the time when the further exam-  
ination of our claims could be taken  
up, I received the letter which I  
enclose. In consideration of this I  
think there is no occasion to incur  
further expenses at present in prose-  
cuting this claim, and as all has

been accomplished which  
any commission can now  
do. I would suggest that you  
make up a final Report at the  
close of the present year.

The state has reason to  
imprudent itself on the present  
state of her account with the  
General Court. & such a Report  
would be exceedingly gratifying  
to our people.
