NEW YORK CITY, November 2, 1900.

DEAR SIR :

On November 8, 1900, Major-General OLIVER OTIS HOWARD, U. S. Army (retired), will complete his seventieth year. This event calls to mind his distinguished military services, his earnest public spirit, and his untiring energy and interest in religious and educational fields. It also recalls the fact that he is one of the oldest living Army Commanders.

In order to commemorate the anniversary of his birth, and to gather together a large number of his comrades, long separated, to meet again under auspices at once happy and congenial, his friends in the Army and Navy and in civil life have proposed a banquet in his honor, to be given at the Waldorf-Astoria, on November 8, 1900, at 6.30 P.M.

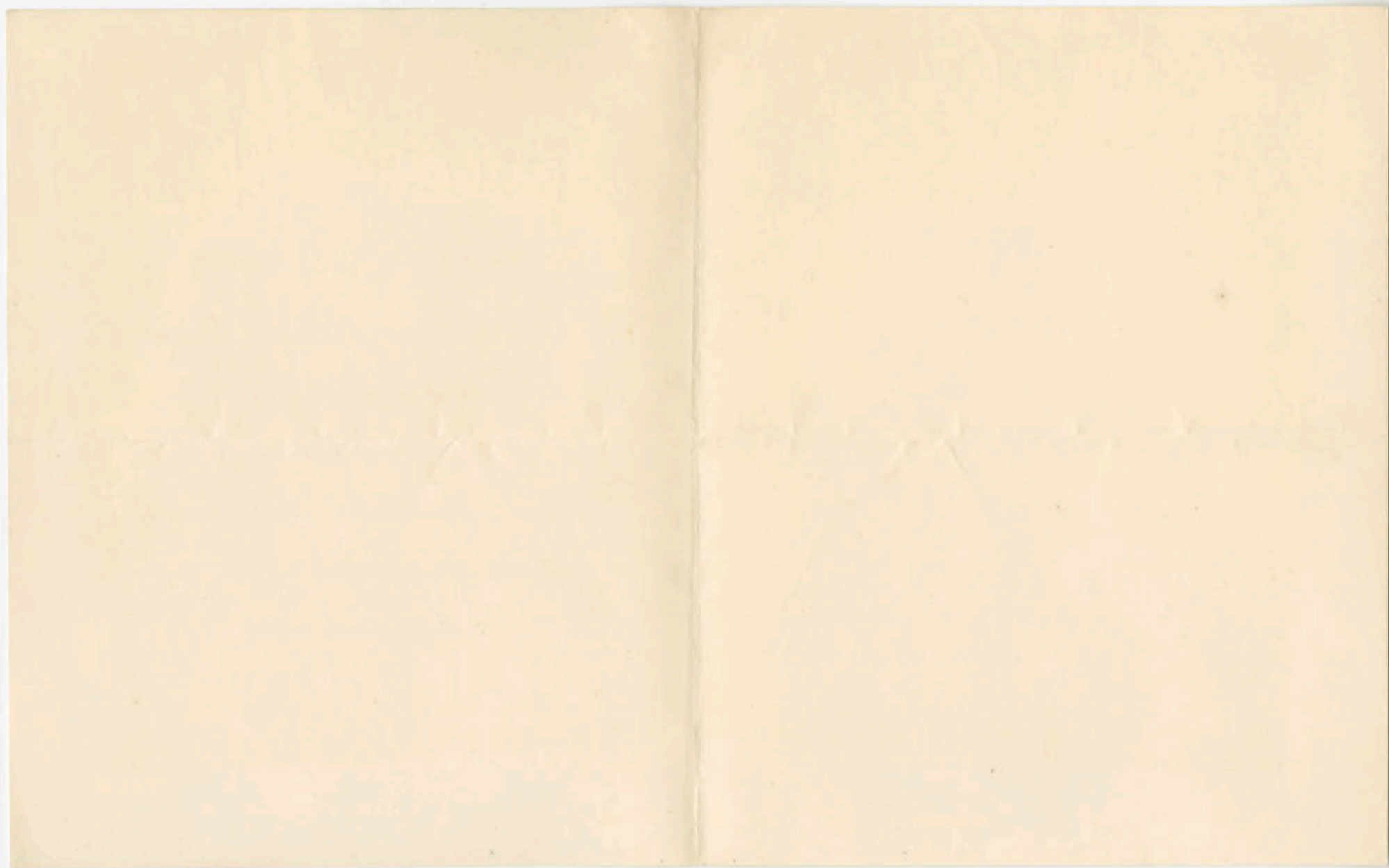

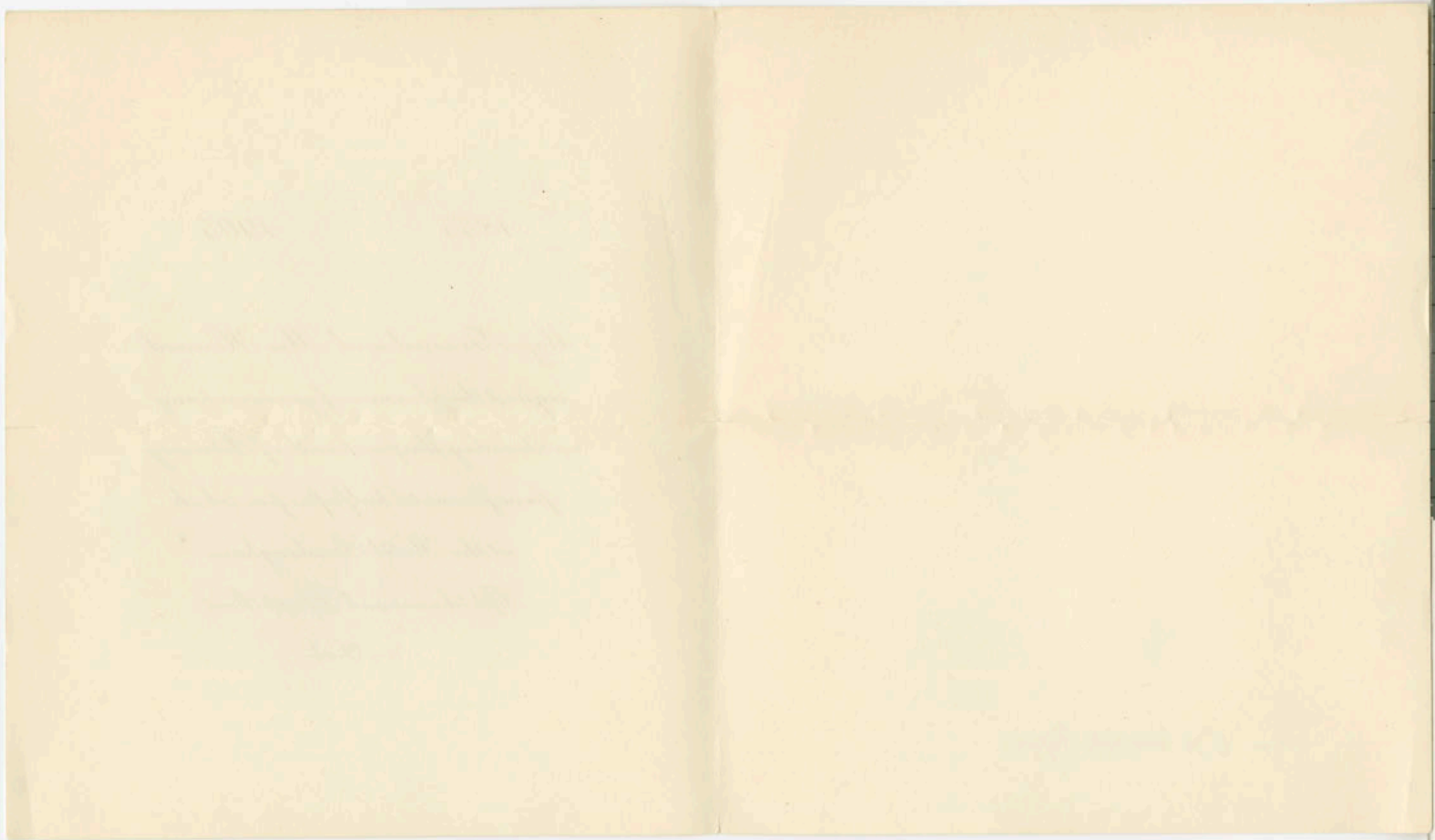

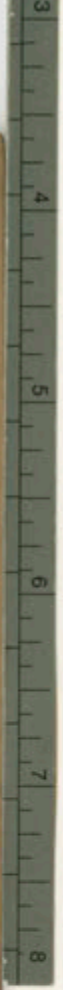
