I thank you in anticipation of your early answer to my letter. I remain

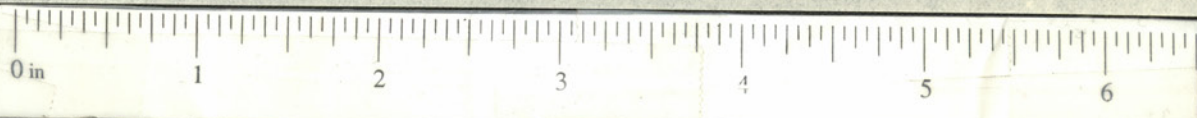
