My dear Mother,

I am sorry

to disappoint you in the time
I set for my visit to Leeds. Mrs

Walt was quite sick after you
left. Her sister has left, and if we should
go to Leeds she would be alone - so we
have concluded to settle our affairs -
buy up goods to be transported & a
before we leave at all - We will do
all this as soon as we can - Then we
will take Mrs Walt to Lewiston &
go on to Leeds - It may be Friday
and it may be not till Saturday. I
hope you got some well & happy - Give
my love to all - Do not try to meet us at
the cars - We can get a horse at the depot.
I think we shall start for N. York from
Leeds. You - I wish to see you & have a long talk with
Lizzie Sands & you - Give your affectionate
