


Davenport Jawa January 1. 1868 Dear General! Permit me to present to you on this day the heartful mishas for your happeiner in the New year. In thankful recollection I remember the time, when I had the honor to ourse under your command General and the Kind convideration, which you always bestorred upon me. - will never be forgotten by me. During a short stay in Washington Toalled on you General but you being on an inspection tour, I was not able to inform you perromally that I received an appointment as 2nd Limitemant 95 Ml. S. Jufly and that I was ordered to report to Major General T. H. Milson for engineer duty on the Upper and Lower Rapids of the Mississippi, upon which works I have been formerly engaged as Gost. liv. Engineer. The work here is of the greatest interest and being under the command of ouch an amiable superior Officer, as General Wilson is, it mather my life quite happy. I cannot deny that I feel much honored by being now an Officer

in the regular thomy. I have been the greatest part of life a solde and I like to be ouch further . Now General I hope you will pardon me for having directed this letter to you, but it is always for me a somrere duty to remem a kindnest, which you so often bestored upon me.
