It is hoped and believed that this stoppage of the bouties will in no manner diminish the number of lecrichs, but that the freedmen will honor thencelved by showing to the Country, that they have a higher notive for joining the army, than the more bounty. and that they will come forward by thousands, and Eagerly unbrace the apportunity of becoming soldiers. to secure their non freedom and that of their race forever.
