We, the undersigned petitioners, residing along the line of the Dalles Military Road, would respectfully draw your attention to the impassable condition of said road for the transportation of troops or mails of the United States, there being no bridges along the line of said road, especially across the John Day river, a stream, which is not fordable during three months in each year and is necessary to be crossed at six different points, and the road otherwise does not permit of its regular use as a wagon road for common travel, in accordance with the act of the Legislative Assembly, approved October 20<sup>th</sup> 1868.

Therefore we would respectfully request your intercession as the Military Commander of this Department, with the owners of said Dalles Military Road so far, as to compel them, to repair said road in a suitable condition for travel.
