It is not doubted, however, that they fully equal, if they do not exceed the proportion of the book records.

As the records of the late Bureau show a considerable amount of its work, so far as related to the payment of bounties &c., to have been conducted through many of the Cashiers of the F. S. & T. Co., (who, it would seem, virtually succeeded the regular agents from time to time) it may be that a large proportion of the missing records are now in their possession.
