Beginning at Dragoon Springs near Dragoon Pass in Arigona, to run North Heslerty touching the North base of Chinicahua Mts. to a point on summit of Peloncillo Into. or Steins Teato range; thence South Easterly along said range through Steins Feat to the New Mexican Boundary; thence due South to mexican boundary; thence Hesterly along Said boundary fifty five miles; thence Northerty fol lowing substantially the Hestern base of the Dragon mountains to the place of beginning. This general description will obtain till a careful locating of points and lines by Survey shall be made.
