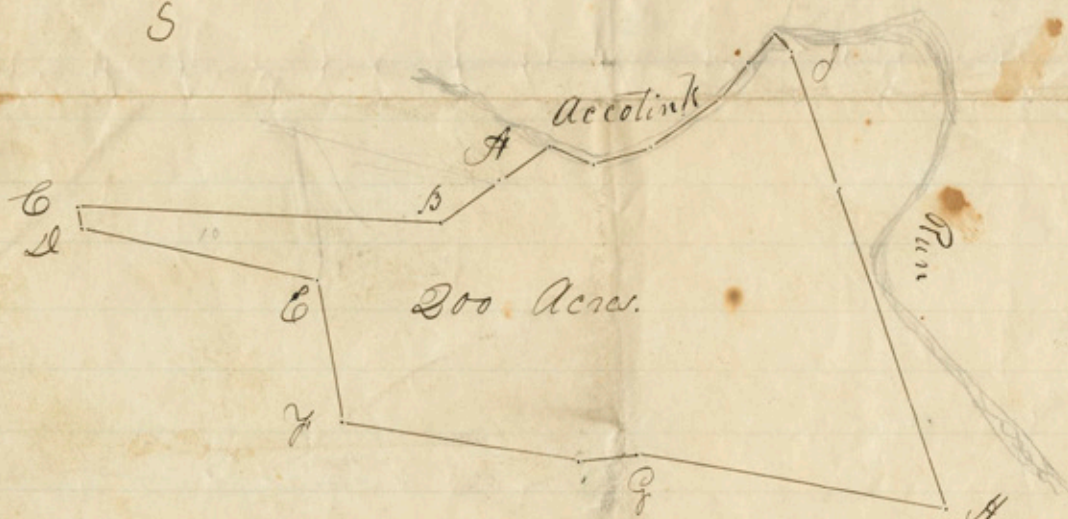


Scale 80 poles per Inch

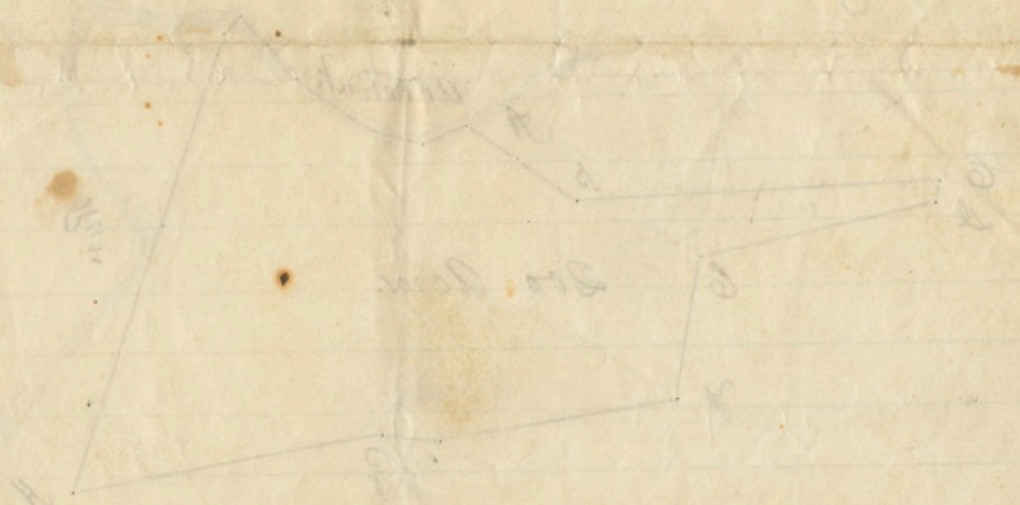
