your great-great grandfather -

Rowland Bailey Howard I. was 3rd cousin to the great New England poet - Wm Cullen Bryant. his (RBI) great grandfather Seth I had a brother Abiel (1704-1777) whose daughter Silence married Dr Philip Bryant - their son Dr Peter Bryant was the father of William Cullen Bryant.

This Abiel Howard was the first of the family (so far as I can find) to graduate from Harvard - & also the first from Plymouth County - He also was a doctor.

I thought you might have fun checking this - am I right?
