

#### CHARLOTTE, EMILY AND ANN BRONTE.

Daughters of the Rev. Patrick Brontë, whose lives were a constant struggle against poverty and misfortune. Dissimilar in disposition they shared a passion for writing and literature. Early experiences as governesses and later the unsuccessful venture of a school were disillusioning. A gifted brother disappointed every hope and their father became partially blind. Emily and Ann died in 1848 before recognition came to them, but Charlotte, who lived till 1855, knew fame in her lifetime.
