Thursday 15th August 1833

Agree to leave the machine with Nicholas Gray
if he did not conclude to buy to write a week
from Saturday went up & got the horses of the
Blake Horse and took him down to Gray's
rigged the wagon and took out and myself

Friday 16th started for Waterford with three horses wrote
forty or fifty miles put up in Ballston on

Saturday 17th rode in to town ^{Waterford} found no good
spirit some prospect of selling here yet -

Conversed with Van Vorst about a pair
of gray mares ^{for a mare} went to see the machine
machine &

Sunday 18th went to church twice or three times full
some better very sore lip neck better some

Monday 19th

Rose at 5 went 7 miles saw Sherman
Van Vorst & others come home wrote to
Delevin Thompson etc. I had prepared
to take a machine out to Tivoli
went out & elevated & passed a round in half
returned with the machine to Tivoli

Tuesday 20th Went from 16 to 15 miles through the sand
with a machine set up at Sherman's house
some spectators no sale

Wednesday 21th Rose early went & showed the machine
to a number they would not give a
penny liked the machine but not the man
returned within a mile & half Tivoli fatigued
and sorry came down to Tivoli after tea

Thursday 22th Remained at Tivoli took boat went to Albany
Very unwell all this day homeward homeward
should be glad to have my wife name me

Thursday 23 Went up to Mr. Almeda and exhibit a machine
to a number of spectators all well pleased no sale
yet came home found Peter D. had just arrived
from Cannagharrow.

Saturday 24 Just for the horses and exhibited a machine
at Mr. Ten Brooks all the village come
to see all admired the operation but
affected no sale rode in the evening to
Frog to see The Pictures of Adam & Eve
surprisingly painting surpassing anything.
I soon saw Oh! That my dear Ezra had
been with me.

Sunday 25 Went to church after which wrote
to A. B. Gardin a long letter regar-
ding to be recalled.

Monday 26 traded horses with Danvers. Danvers gave
\$160 to back went out on the Pebbles and
sold 1/4 machine.

Thursday 27 Sold 1/4 to Isaac & Travis and 1/6
to Almeda and exchanged horses
with him and let him ride Charley
left to start for Marin and
I for Cannagharrow came on the
rail road and thus took the packet
from Schenectady.

Wednesday 28 Arrived at Cannagharrow this morning
had an interview with Mr. Hale nothing done
to his advantage sent some elaborate nuts

about the country

Thursday 29 went out to Mr. Groves saw the machine
no one seemed to buy time dull could raise but
a little attention from others to my business returned
to Mr. Graves read in the evening Gil Blas

Friday 30th Rose in the morning went to the office
opened a letter from my dear wife and set down
to answer it. Tidt some advertisements up the same
Saturday 31st Conversed with many about machine
Groves wrote instead of letter mail a
letter to my wife

Sunday 1st September while at church Farbat come
had hope the machine at Johnstown the chain
come to pieces & he had broken the cog wheel a
sad affair wrote to Chandler for another and
to Belieau to go to Wittenford for a machine

Monday 2nd Went to Saltmans Ells Nellis and also
over Palestine they liked the machine well
but would not buy until they see another
that is to be set up at Lips event so see it
think it will not thresh clean went to Groves
and Groves told him to keep the machine until
they gave him \$175 dollars returned to Farbat

Tuesday 3rd George Saltman came down in steer
of his father took his note & fifty dollars

Wednesday 4th went to Saltmans took the old man
note for \$25 and \$725 the promiss to endorse
it but when I came made excuse said
it was not worth right no letters can
do nothing more to advantage shall go to
Johnstown tomorrow

Thursday 5 Machine arrived from Watterford this morning Sold it to Mr John G. Hale for his grey horse \$75 dollars in a note and he paid the freight ~~of \$25~~
took the Stage & Wagon so Mr Briggs Johnston T. went to Fultons mill got the new wheel Friday 6 undertook to put on the new wheel and went to thrashing the rounds came out caught in the machine and finally broke the new wheel I started Cartbox to Watterford with both horses to send one as soon as possible

Saturday 7 went out and invited company to see the machine Monday

Sunday 8 stayed at Briggs, Lertell must night and went to the farm ~~then sent for the wheel~~

Monday 9 Went early about a mile and brought the wheel on my back filed it an hour or two and put it on and went to thrashing the wages soon became loose I fastened them with new ones but had done but little before the horse caught his hind shoe tore them both off and bent the pole strap & came out of the machine Tuesday got him shod put on again and the wheel became loose again fastened that and thrashed a little and left the machine in tolerable good order & good credit as can be expected

Wednesday started for Watterford via Schenectady Albany

Thursday 12th Went in the morning called on
Woolli Gould walked with him to see
over a Clark in store took stage for
Walla Walla arrived at noon left & had not
arrived went up to see the Grey house

Friday 13th Mr Peoples came and wanted us
to put in machine in order had got out
of Aspin New my letters wrote one to Ward
Saturday Harbor and Lander went up to public
to see the machine took down the shaft
and wheels to the shop.

Sunday 15th Went to church 3 times this day & evening
Monday 15th went up with the work men carried
the wheels of the machine saved and
put it together and think it will be now
permanent returned and found a man from
Princeton Schenectady Co 2½ miles from Rotterdam
Browns Tear house on the Cannal 10 miles
from Schenectady want to sell a machine
but could not stop them ~~coaster~~ call again
Tuesday 17th Presented Elles note for \$75 to the
Directors and after some time got
it discounted recd \$73. 47
Mr Davis spoke well of the endorser

Wednesday 18th Had some talk with Mr Beach of Chittenden
but could not sell him any territory until he
knew more of the machine wrote to Mr
Brayton New Albany and to Goff & Page
Phelps Ontario Co 4640

Thursday 19th Rainy day nothing done however
and Palmont ride waiting for Robinson
Went to the shop and charged them to make the
Friday machine so it will hold together in future

To a Mr Samuel S Wheeler of Westville Albany
called I went to the shop showed the
machine as well as I could in its present
state he said if he could get some to
join he would say would let us know
soon

Saturday 21 Went to the shop to see about the machines
no business occurring of consequence today
Recd Paulding's bill of travel - good

Sunday 22 Went to church etc

Monday 23 Recd a letter from Joseph Wing of
Duaneburgh Shohamie Co and answered it and
directed to Esperance Shohamie Co.

Tuesday 24 Went to the shop to try to hurry
on the completion of the machines
no calls, read from B. Hall

Wednesday 25th

Mr Maywood of Greenbush Rensselaer Co

Wanted to see a machine saw it liked it
thinks he shall buy with Mr Ketcham and
others in Schenectada where he says ~~they~~
four will join to buy as they have not
seen one yet have recd my letter respecting the

Thursday 26 Thasbot went up to try to trade with
Bardstown for old machine for Vandever if he does
not trade for that he will probably conclude
to have a new one for the ~~fall~~ in Hrce \$140
